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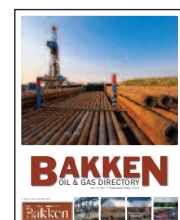

*Q. What is the official name of your company?*

A. ClearSpan Fabric Structures

*Q. What do you most want people to know about your company?*

A. We are the industry leader in tension fabric structures and provide economical, design-build solutions for any application and any budget.

*Q. Where is your company located?*

A. We manufacture and distribute out of our centrally located center in Dyersville, IA.

*Q. What year was the company founded and by whom?*

A. In 1979 by Barry Goldsher and Chuck Clark.

*Q. What is your company's primary business activity?*

A. ClearSpan Fabric Structures provides design-build solutions for material, equipment and other storage needs. ClearSpan buildings feature abundant natural light and spacious interiors without internal support posts. With minimal foundation requirements, the structures can be permanent or temporary, and they are easy to relocate. Made in the USA, they can be built to any length and up to 300' wide.

*Q. Are there important projects the company is currently a part of or has done recently?*

A. Recently, ClearSpan installed two of our Hercules Truss Arch Buildings for an oilfield services company in Montana. The

fabric structures, one at 73' wide by 100' long and the other at 73' wide by 160' long, were installed using our Helical Anchor foundation, which requires minimal site prep and rapid installation. Our 73' wide design is our special Turnkey Building, which means manufacturing, delivery and installation is included for one low price. For this project in Montana, the customer also added end walls and doors so they could securely store their sand sacs for oil drilling.



*Q. Is the company changing any of its services or products?*

A. Our customers continue to look at fast construction timelines. We continue to develop building and foundation solutions that allow us to build fast and at low cost.

strength or its edge over the competition?

A. Two areas that really separate us from the competition are our in-house financing and our product warranty. Pending credit approval, our customers can qualify for up to seven years financing with zero money down and no interest, as well as no payments for one year. The warranties on our structures carry a 50-year warranty on the structural steel tubing we use for our trusses and a 20-year warranty on our high-density polyethylene rip-stop and UV-

treated fabric cover.

Q. What new markets, clients or projects did your company attract in the last year?

A. Our fabric structures are classified as the "Buildings of 1,000 Uses." Just when we think we've covered every industry and application, another customized request comes in. We do a lot in the agricultural and equestrian industries and also quite extensively serve the municipality and indus-

trial arenas as well. Our products have been distributed all across North America, Central America, the Caribbean, Pacific islands, Europe and Asia.

## Nominations up

Most acres nominated for August NDTL lease auction lie on Bakken fringe

Oil July 1, the Minerals Management Division of the North Dakota Department of Trust Lands released a list of nominated tracts for the department's August oil and gas lease auction, and said only in the total acreage the highest for an August lease auction since 2006, but more than twice the amount of the acreage of the Bakken petroleum system. However, the nominated acreage has not yet been vetted and some could possibly be pulled before the final auction list is issued to the bidders.

All together a total of 54,500 acres in 169 tracts across 13 western and central North Dakota counties were nominated. That is the highest nominated acreage for an August lease auction since 2006, and over 22,000 acres higher than the 10-year August average of 32,400 acres (see chart). Minerals Management Division Director Steve Combs says the acreage is "unusually" high, and believes, part of the reason is that a number of leases, all of which have been of five years, are held by novices who have been of the decision and are on the verge of expiration. More than half of the nominated acres are in

## NuStar aims to grow storage

Great Northern steps on for about 30,000 barrels of 70,000 additional capacity

NuStar Energy, which has 47 million barrels of total storage capacity, is looking market expansion to plans for growing its storage market in Louisiana by tapping into an oil basin in North Dakota. The company is looking for the oil's oil and gas reserves and has been in the oil and gas business since 1997. NuStar announced in late June that it had signed a three-year agreement with Great Northern Oil Co. to move Bakken crude and heavy Canadian crude to the St. James facility, starting in the fourth quarter.

NuStar's expansion plans also include converting one dock at St. James to handle export and loading another, reversing its traditional role of accepting only inbound crude shipments.

Damon Greer, the company's senior vice president of marketing and business development, said NuStar wants to be as open as possible to carrying any size of crude oil.

He said recent discussions aimed at reaching new contracts involve Bakken producers and

## U.S. reserves rise 45%

Ernst & Young study: Bakken system, other tight plays contributes to growth

The Bakken petroleum system and other tight, unconventionally produced oil plays were largely responsible for a 45 percent rise in U.S. oil reserves over the past five years, according to a recent study by accounting firm Ernst & Young.

Investments in the U.S. oil and gas sector also reached their highest level in almost a decade, the study revealed.

The Ernst & Young study does not provide reserve and capital spending totals for specific tight oil plays. Rather, reserves and spending were grouped from year-end reports submitted to the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission by

the country's 50 largest publicly traded companies. The study covers both onshore and offshore.

Not done the study notes that the Bakken has the biggest increase in oil reserves among the top 50 in both categories. Conventional Reserves increased 16th in capital spending and 13th in oil reserves, while Shale Reserves in ranked 22nd in capital spending and 19th in oil reserves.

Bakken's reserve potential

However, increased reserves does not double that

# Halcóns operation efficiency leads to improved economics in Bakken

*Company's implementation of drilling and completion modifications continues to yield positive results*

*Q. How would you describe the strategy that drives your company and how will you implement it this year?*

A. Our strategy is to build a significant position in a few scalable liquids-rich plays, prove that position through the drillbit and build a large inventory of de-risked, but un-booked locations. Part of the strategy also includes divesting of all assets that do not compete for capital and/or are considered non-core. As we execute our plan over time, we expect to grow production, reserves and cash flow.

*Q. How have high oil prices and low gas prices affected your business?*

A. When we started Halcón we made a conscious decision to focus on oil instead of gas. By the time we sold Petrohawk, it was apparent that due to the large, new supplies from shale gas fields, gas prices were going to be under pressure for quite some time. We felt like the economics on oil plays were strong and likely to stay that way for the foreseeable future. Since we don't know what commodity prices will do in the future, we hedge approximately 80 percent of what we expect to produce in order to protect cash flow.

*Q. What results are you seeing from the modifications made to drilling and completions in the Williston Basin?*

A. The Company continues to modify its drilling completions techniques in an effort to improve recoveries and reduce costs. Based on improved results to date, Halcón has revised the EUR estimates higher for its type curves. The Company is now using one average type curve for all Bakken and Three Forks wells drilled in the Fort Berthold area, and one average type curve for all Bakken wells drilled in Williams County. In the Fort Berthold area, the average Bakken/Three Forks type curve increased by 39% to 801 thousand barrels of oil equivalent (Mboe), while the average Bakken type curve EUR in Williams County was re-

vised higher by 43% to 477 Mboe.

Data suggests that wells completed with slickwater fracs in the Williston Basin are outperforming wells completed with cross-linked gel, all else being equal. As a result, Halcón plans to complete the majority of its future operated wells in the Williston Basin using the slickwater frac technique. All Company-operated wells online in the Fort Berthold area that were completed via a slickwater frac are outperforming the new 801 Mboe type curve.

Additionally, early stage downspacing tests continue to yield positive results, and indicate the potential for up to 16 locations per drilling spacing unit (DSU) in the Fort Berthold area, which would more than triple the Company's drilling inventory in this area alone compared to the previous development plan.

*Q. You recently announced the TMS as one of your core plays. What are your plans for this region?*

A. We currently have approximately 307,000 net acres leased or under contract in what we think is the geologic core of this play. Approximately 77 percent of the acreage is located in Southwest Mississippi and Louisiana Florida Parishes, also known as the "Eastern TMS". We plan to operate an average of 2 rigs for the remainder of 2014 and spud 10-12 gross operated wells in this play. We also expect to participate in several non-operated wells. We have been working the Tuscaloosa Marine Shale from a geologic standpoint and monitoring industry activity in the play for quite some time. Our strategy is to identify scalable and repeatable resources plays where we feel we can meaningfully improve the economics by applying our extensive technical experience. We believe the TMS fits that strategy, and we're excited about our position in the play.

*Q. Last year you announced a new play, El Halcón. What are your plans for development?*

A. We currently have approximately 100,000 net acres in El

Halcón, which is located in East Texas in and around Brazos and Burleson Counties. El Halcón is an extension of the South Texas Eagle Ford shale play in which our management team here at Halcón drilled the discovery well in 2008 while at Petrohawk. We've identified +/- 1,000 drilling locations. The reservoir is 200' thick with high oil saturation and good porosity. It lies between the Buda and Austin Chalk formations. We have experienced significant production growth here; going from almost no production to over 7,000 net barrels of oil equivalent per day in 12 months. El Halcón is definitely an area of focus for us. It represents approximately 40 percent of our total drilling and completions budget for 2014. We recently drilled the record well in the play and hope to translate improvements in well costs and efficiencies across all areas of the company.

*Q. You have divested or are planning to divest multiple properties this year. How does that fit within your strategy and impact your plan going forward?*

A. Last year we divested properties that had an impact of approximately 9,000 barrels of oil equivalent per day from non-core conventional assets located throughout the U.S. for \$450 million. Estimated proved reserves associated with these divested properties was approximately 23 million barrels of oil equivalent. These were all non-core properties with high LOE and limited upside.

In addition, we expect to close on another divestiture for approximately \$450 million related to some producing and undeveloped assets in East Texas in the second quarter of this year.

It has always been our strategy to sell properties that do not fit our model and reinvest the proceeds into our core areas. We are always working towards having a tightly focused, quality property set. With these divestments we have become a more concentrated oil producer and expect to realize lower operating costs from a more concentrated portfolio.

## Q AND A

*Q. What is the greatest challenge you face this year?*

A. Execution is always a risk inherent to the oil and gas business, but we think this risk is minimized by our team's successful track record and strong history of solid execution. We also believe that technology will ultimately drive recoveries and economics, which is why we invest heavily in our technical team. Halcón is at the forefront of adoption and application of cutting-edge unconventional drilling and completion technology to drive well performance.

*Q. What is the one thing you want investors to know?*

A. How far we have come in such a short period of time. Halcón has only been around for two years, and in that time, we've grown a \$550 million start-up into a multi-billion dollar company that has hundreds of thousands of quality acres in some of the most prolific plays in the U.S. We have a management team that is experienced, has realized great success for shareholders in past ventures and is working hard to do so again. We are on track to deliver on our strategy. There's still work to do— delimiting our acreage, continuing to search for other resource play opportunities and realizing operational improvements—but we are well on our way.

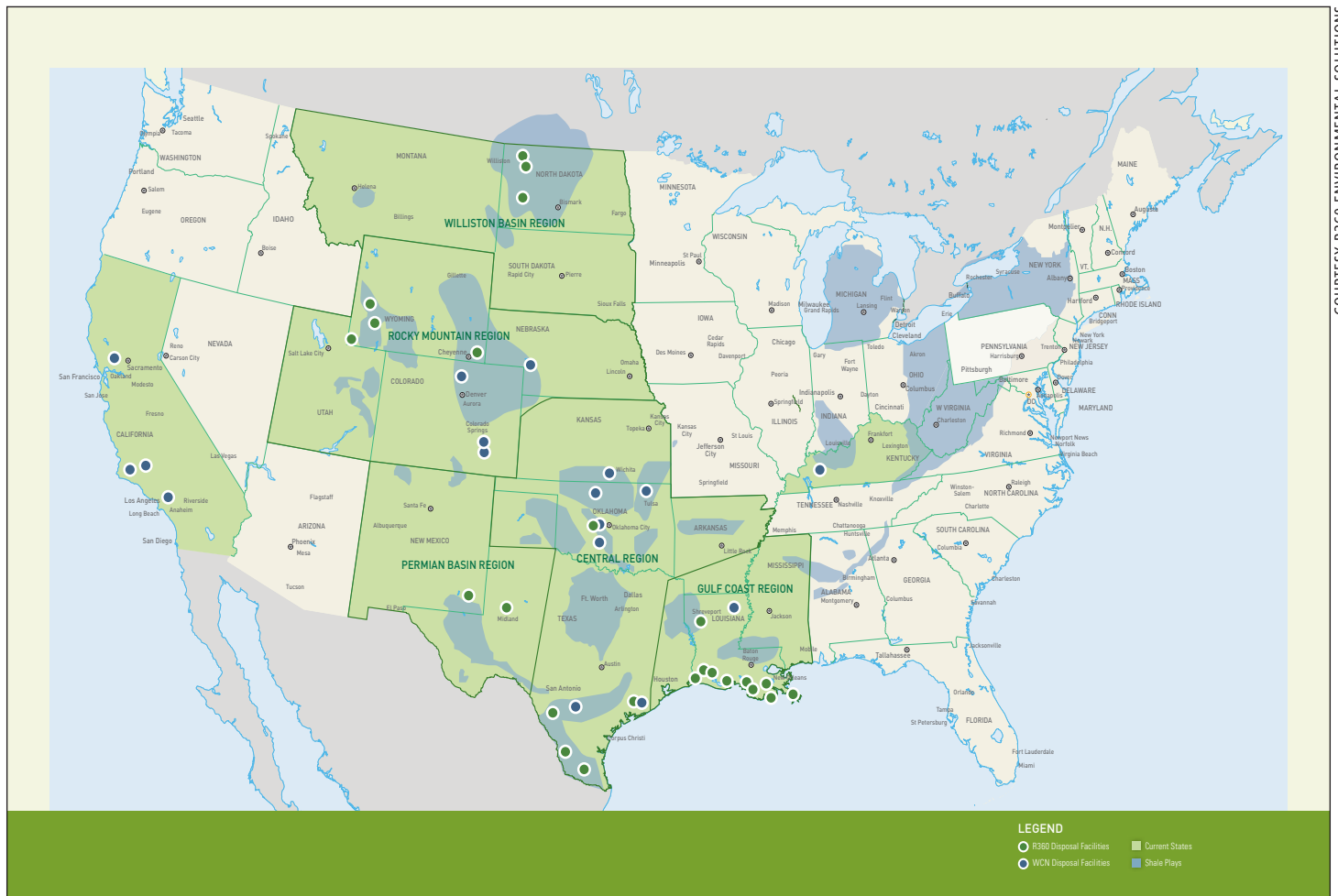

**Attention readers:** The following upstream Exploration & Production listings include well operators in North Dakota and Montana that produce at least 600 barrels of oil per day from the Bakken petroleum system, which has a number of geological zones, including Three Forks. One significant Williston Basin Canada operator, Lightstream Resources, is listed, but without daily production because Saskatchewan does not report Bakken well output.

The only non-operators listed in this section are Northern Oil and Gas and PetroShale because of the size of their investments and their involvement in their partners' operations. The Bakken Oil & Gas Directory is essentially a marketing tool for regular advertisers in Petroleum News Bakken — a value-added product, per se. But it is also meant to be of use to Petroleum News Bakken readers, so oil and gas companies, the heart of the activity in any oil province, are listed in the directory under Exploration & Production Companies, whether or not they are regular advertisers in the newspaper.

Associations and government offices involved in the Williston Basin's Bakken are also listed, whether or not they advertise, as a service to Petroleum News Bakken readers, all of whom receive a copy of this directory.

The production numbers included in the directory are from October — the latest month reported to the states of North Dakota and Montana by most of the companies — and exclude production from wells on confidential status. The information comes directly from Petroleum News Bakken's analysis of information released by the North Dakota Industrial Commission and the Montana Board of Oil & Gas Conservation Commission.

Production from Northern Oil and Gas and PetroShale is not listed because they do not operate any wells and so the aforementioned state agencies do not collect production information from them. Both companies' websites, however, are listed herein. It is possible production information (or contacts for more information) is listed on those sites.

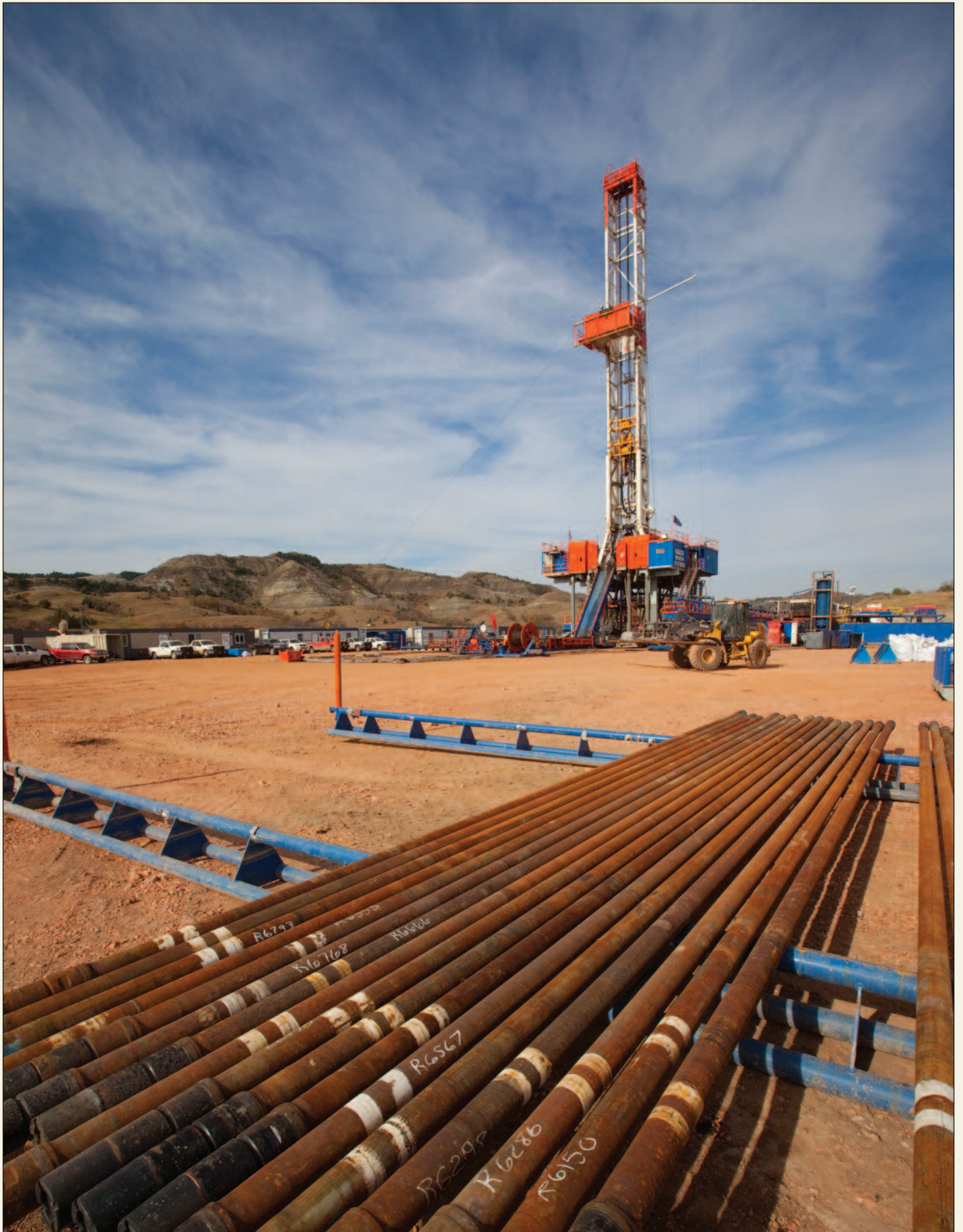

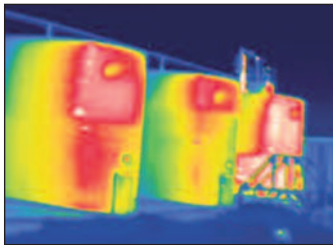
