# Alaska Railroad, providing reliable transport of goods and services since 1923

*Alaska's Railbelt is the cost effective and environmentally friendly choice for heavy freight*

*Q. What is the official name of your company?*

A. Alaska Railroad Corporation

*Q. Is your firm a subsidiary or affiliate of other companies?*

*If so, please name those firms and their relationship to your company.*

A. The Alaska Railroad is owned by the State of Alaska.

*Q. What do you most want people to know about your company?*

A. Our freight services extend far beyond the length of our own tracks. We work with other providers, trucking companies, and barge services as needed to provide seamless transport of goods and materials between Alaska and all of North America.



*Q. Where is your company located?*

A. Our headquarters are located in downtown Anchorage, and we have facilities in communities all along the Railbelt.

*Q. What year was the company founded and by whom?*

A. The Alaska Engineering Commission was found in 1914 by

President Woodrow Wilson as a means to transport valuable resources from Alaska's interior to an ice-free port city. The commission built and connected 470 miles of track from Fairbanks to Seward; President Warren Harding traveled to Alaska in 1923 to celebrate the completion of the new rail line and drive in the ceremonial golden spike.

*Q. What is your company's primary business activity?*

A. While the Alaska Railroad is perhaps best known for passenger service, freight makes up the bulk of the railroad's revenue. Our freight customers represent a variety of industries: oil and gas, mining, construction, TOFC, the military, and more.

*Q. Are there important projects the company is currently a part of or has done recently?*

A. We're always keeping an eye on new projects on the North Slope; we've proven to be a cost-effective way to move goods and materials up north, and are always interested in the opportunity to support a project in that way. In the same vein, we're certainly interested in the progress of the Ambler mining district project. Internally, our engineering department has undertaken a bridge improvement program that will allow Alaska Railroad bridges to safely support additional weight - enhancing our ability to transport dense and heavy freight.



*Q. How many employees does your company have?*

A. The Alaska Railroad has 550 year-round employees, rising to 700 during the summer season.

*Q. Describe the equipment your company uses and are there any new equipment purchases planned?*

A. We use 4000-series SD70MAC locomotives to haul freight across 500 miles of Alaska. Railcars vary based on cargo – tank cars for fuel, hopper cars for coal and gravel, flat cars for TOFC services, and so on. We recently purchased 56 new 89-foot flat cars, as a great enhancement to our TOFC fleet. Over the last two years, the Alaska Railroad purchased four new van loaders to boost efficiency. We've also recently invested in new equipment to enhance our track maintenance program.

*Q. Is your company expanding any of its operations or locations?*

A. We are currently pursuing an expansion of our freight dock in Seward; widening the dock would allow additional industrial traffic to connect to our main line.

*Q. Is the company changing any of its services or products?*

A. Our core service remains the same: seamless, reliable, cost-effective transport of goods across Alaska and beyond.

*Q. What is your company's main strength or its edge over the competition?*

A. There is no more cost-efficient, environmentally friendly way to transport freight along Alaska's Railbelt – particularly high-volume and heavy freight.

*Q. What new markets, clients or projects did your company attract in the last year?*

A. The Alaska Railroad recently received renewed approval from the Federal Railroad Administration to transport liquid natural gas in ISO containers by rail, in support of continued expansion of LNG in the Fairbanks market.

*Q. What is the most challenging work/contract the company has undertaken?*

A. Seamless service is a great benefit to be able to offer our freight customers, but it necessitates relying on partners in the Lower 48 and beyond. One impact of the pandemic has been a reduction in the availability of trucks and drivers; it can be a big challenge to find reliable trucking services to pick up and deliver

products to the rail line.

*Q. What are the biggest obstacles to completing work your company undertakes?*

A. Staff retention can be difficult for seasonal positions, which can present a big challenge given that many of our seasonal positions still require extensive specialized training.

*Q. What do you see as your company's biggest challenge in the next five years?*

A. Asset maintenance is an ongoing challenge in operating a year-round, full-service railroad across 500 miles of Alaska. Over the next five years, we plan to make significant capital investments in rolling stock, track repairs and bridge improvements.

*Q. Does your company have an anniversary or other landmark event coming up?*

A. Yes, the centennial of the completion of the Alaska Railroad's main line is in 2023.

*Q. What is the average length of time employee's work for the company?*

A. Almost half of our current employees have been with the Alaska Railroad 10 years or more, and it's not uncommon for people to hit 25 and 30+ year milestones. We have had a few 50-year employees which includes one active employee currently at 53 years of service.

*Q. What is your company's safety record? What steps does the company take to ensure a safe work environment?*

A. Over the last few years, the Alaska Railroad has been working to implement the incident-free culture program. This effort is paying dividends: the railroad tied its record for the lowest injury frequency in company history, at 4.8 in 2020.

*Q. Has your company been involved in any community projects or charity events?*

A. Yes, the Alaska Railroad supports a wide variety of local non-profit organizations with in-kind donations of rail tickets. Additionally, the Alaska Railroad is part of a long-running school-business partnership with Government Hill Elementary.

A. Coffman Engineers, Inc.

*Q. What do you most want people to know about your company?*

*Q. Where is your company located?*

A. In Alaska, our office is located in downtown Anchorage. We

have 18 additional office locations throughout the lower 48 and Pacific Rim.

*Q. What year was the company founded and by whom?*

A. Coffman was founded in 1979 by Dave Coffman. One of Coffman's very first jobs was located on Alaska's North Slope supporting oil production.

*Q. What is your company's primary business activity?*

A. Coffman is a multidiscipline engineering firm in Alaska offering a variety of engineering disciplines including civil, structural, mechanical, electrical, chemical/process, corrosion control, fire protection, piping, and instrumentation and controls engineering, as well as commissioning and project management services. We work in the upstream, midstream, and downstream markets of the oil, gas, and petrochemical industry. We also work in the industrial, federal, local government, and commercial market sectors.

*Q. Are there important projects the company is currently a part of or has done recently?*

A. Coffman has many longstanding relationships with owners throughout Alaska's oil and gas production, transportation, and processing industry. We have worked with many of these clients for more than 40 years. These relationships have allowed us to work





on a variety of projects throughout Alaska. Our work includes numerous and ongoing jobs across the North Slope, various production platforms and facilities throughout the Cook Inlet, the Trans Alaska Pipeline, the Port of Alaska, and much more.

*Q. How many employees does your company have?*

A. Coffman has 110 employees located in our Anchorage, Alaska office. We have 600 total employees with 18 additional offices companywide.

*Q. Describe the equipment your company uses and are there any new equipment purchases planned? Does your company use any unique equipment or software for project support?*

A. One unique capability Coffman offers is the combination of 3D laser scanning and 3D CAD modeling. When used together, the combination of 3D scanning and 3D CAD modeling is a powerful tool for green field and brown field work. Over the years, many facilities have not kept up with as-building their drawings and when it comes time for updates, multiple and lengthy site visits are needed to as-found current conditions. Laser scanning can be done in one site visit depending on the size and scope of the project and provide a 3D scan of the entire project area with high detail and the ability to take measurement from the designer/engineer's desk. These laser scans can then be loaded in an AutoCAD drawing, and a 3D design software can be used to design civil, structural, mechanical, and electrical components. This helps bring more accuracy to tie-in locations, helps avoid potential conflict/clashes, and can help with routing through complex and crowded areas.

*Q. Is your company expanding any of its operations or locations?*

A. Coffman continues to grow its presence in the lower 48 through several recently opened offices.

*Q. Is the company changing any of its services or products?*

A. Coffman has added chemical/process engineering capabilities to our long list of engineering offerings to Alaska's oil, gas, and refining industry. Coffman's process engineering capabilities include process engineering support for all project phases; P&ID/PFD development; heat and material balance preparation; process simulation creation and modification; equipment sizing, specification, and selection; instrumentation and valve sizing, specification, and selection; process optimization and debottlenecking; project basis of design development; process control narrative development; relief valve sizing and evaluation/audit of existing relief valves; and process pumping systems.

Coffman has also added fire protection engineering in the last few years, including a group focused on industrial facilities. Our team provides fire protection engineering for tankage, modules, and equipment for the oil and gas industry.

### Lynden companies team up to deliver supplies to Anacortes

As reported by Lynden News Aug. 3, Lynden companies stepped up to help the City of Anacortes, Washington, when it experienced a shortage of chlorine for its regional water system. ## Lynden delivers COVID-19 vaccine to Western Alaska

As reported by Lynden News March 3, since mid-December Lynden has been assisting with the distribution of equipment to administer the COVID-19 vaccine, but now the shipments contain the vaccine itself. Each morning Lynden International District Operations Manager Bob Barndt gets a phone call alerting him to an incoming shipment arriving in Anchorage from Louisville, Kentucky. Barndt meets the plane and personally transfers the boxes of vaccine to Alaska Airlines where they are checked in as critical care shipments - the highest level of service available. After arriving in Bethel, Alaska, the Lynden agent receives the boxes and hand delivers them to hospitals in Bethel, Nome, Kotzebue and Barrow for distribution to village elders and front-line workers in those communities.

"For over 30 years, we have managed deliveries to remote Alaska communities," Barndt explains, "but the vaccine shipments are different than anything else we have handled." Lynden provides white-glove service for each 40-pound box which is red-flagged as hazmat material. The vaccine is packed in dry ice and each box contains a GPS tracking device and temperature monitor.

The vaccine deliveries will continue this year along with personal protective equipment such as gowns and gloves to protect those administering the drugs. Boxes of dry ice are sometimes shipped along with PPE to ensure that the vaccine remains temperature controlled at destination.

In 2009, the State of Alaska also relied on Lynden International to distribute the H1N1 vaccine to more than 400 locations.
